

Course Registration Form

First Aid

In this 4-hour course students learn first aid skills for treating a variety of injuries, such as burns; wounds; head, neck, and back injuries; and heat-and cold related emergencies. Participants also learn to manage sudden illnesses, stroke, seizure, bites, and poisoning. Certification valid for 3 years. The course does not include information on breathing and cardiac emergencies.

Course Fee: \$30.00

CPR for the Lay Responder

This 4-hour course teaches how to perform the following skills on an adult victim (over 12 years of age): breathing emergencies, care for choking, and CPR. This course also teaches you how to recognize the signs and symptoms of a heart attack and how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED) for victims of sudden cardiac arrest until advanced medical personnel arrive and take over. Certification valid for one year.

Course Fee: \$35.00

CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer

This eight-hour course is intended for individuals who are expected to respond to an emergency as part of their job-related duties. Topics include adult, child, and infant rescue breathing, care for choking, CPR, and two rescuer CPR, and use of an AED for victims of sudden cardiac arrest.

Certification valid for one year.

Course Fee: \$60.00

Infant and Child CPR

This 4-hour course is for anyone who spends time with young children. This course covers what to do when an infant or child stops breathing, is choking, or requires CPR. Injury prevention and emergency action steps are also discussed.

Training for separate components is available upon request. Certification valid for one year.

Course Fee: \$40.00

Babysitter Training

This 6-hour course is ideal for current and future babysitters ages 11-15. It teaches them safety in general, and the safety of children in their care. In a fun, interactive environment, participants will learn the responsibilities and qualities of being a good babysitter. This course was developed by the American Red Cross and is supported by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, Girl Scouts of the U.S.A., Boy Scouts of America, YMCA of the U.S.A., Boys and Girls Clubs, and 4H.

Course Fee: \$45.00
